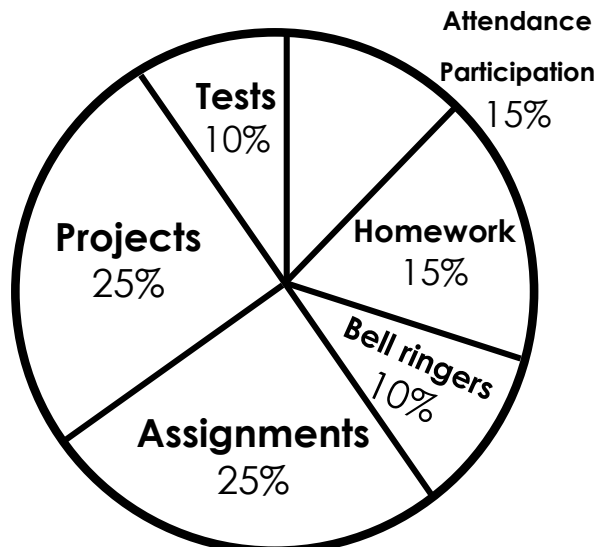

Participation/ Attendance

Students will be graded on their participation and attendance. Students will get a zero for every unexcused absence, and will lose half of their daily points for a tardy. Participation points may be lost for talking/ not working or other distractions from learning. They will begin each day with ten points. Their participation and attendance is worth 15% of their semester grade.

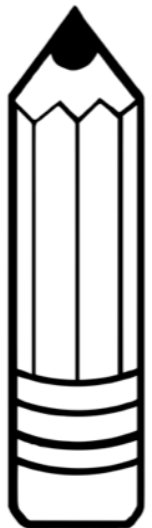

What if I miss a day?

Some More Classroom Expectations

1 Binder Checks

The students will be required to keep their binder organized with bell ringers, resources, vocabulary, interactive notebook, and quizzes. Their binder check will be a project grade at the end of the quarter.

Students will be required to complete a book report each quarter. They will pick a book at their reading level to read, and must be approved by Mrs. Muniz. They will then write a paper, and complete a visual project. More specific instructions will be given with the assignment.

5 IXL

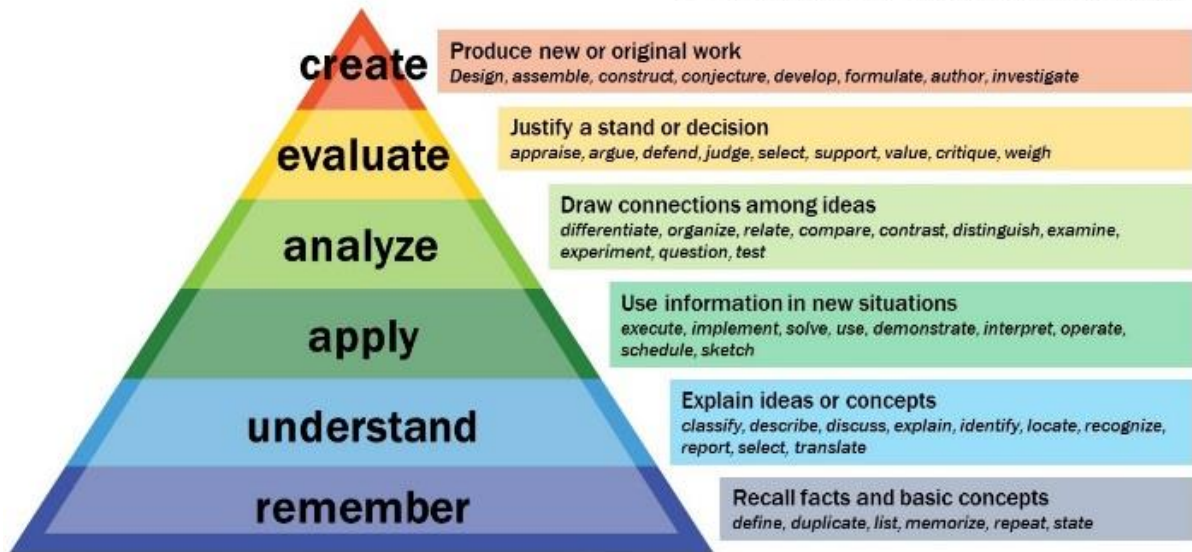
Students will be responsible for completing 30 minutes of IXL time a week. I will give the students an individualized section to work on each week. This is a homework grade.

4 Cell Phones

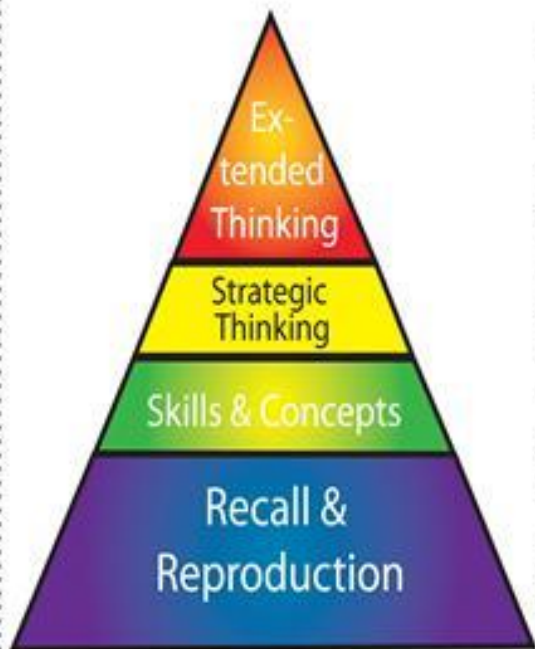
Cell phones will not be used in class. When students arrive, they are required to put their cell phones in a pocket by the door. If a student is caught with one, the first time I will take it until the end of the period. The second time, I will take it to the office where it will need to be picked up by a parent.

Students will work on these skills based on their individual IEP needs and abilities. Students will be expected to reach highest level on both Bloom's Taxonomy and Webb's Depth of Knowledge based on their abilities and previous knowledge on each skill/standard. As their teacher, I am going to push them to use these levels, and create gains in their learning.

4. **Extended Thinking:** Students take information from multiple sources and are asked to apply this information to a new task that requires complex thinking, usually over time. (Ex. A project-based-learning activity or a research paper.)
3. **Strategic Thinking:** Can the student think beyond the text to his world or another text for an answer, or adapt the text to create something new? Can he explain, generalize, or connect ideas from one text to another? Can he evaluate text, formulate opinions, and then explain them?
2. **Skills & Concepts:** Can the student think beyond recalling a fact? Students may be asked to interpret, infer, classify and categorize, organize, compare & contrast, and determine whether fact or opinion, predict, determine cause & effect, apply, reconstruct or sequence a story.
1. **Recall & Reproduction:** Can the student recall a simple fact from the story? Requires a shallow understanding and no analysis.
