Charter Renewal and Facilities:

- The PAPA Charter Renewal Application was recommended without any negative findings. The APS Board of Education committee unanimously approved the renewal. The final Board vote will take place on December 15, 2010.
- Facilities: The meeting with Mr. Winston Brooks scheduled for November 19th was cancelled. We have been unable to schedule another. Mark Tolley assures me that a meeting will take place "soon".
- APS presented to the PSCOC on November 24, 2010. Information about PAPA was included in the presentation (see attached). No news on church building.

Staff:

- Ms. Gena Lawson came on board December 1st. She filled the English and Stagecraft vacancy.
- Mr. Ted Wallack is retiring at the end of the semester. We have advertised for the position and arranged for a UNM senior Math/Education major to substitute until a suitable replacement can be hired.

Policy Review:

- The Staff Handbook has been updated/revised for the Council's review (see attached).

Parents:

- PAPA staff conducted a community meeting attended by approximately 30 families. A packet of information about the upcoming legislative session was provided and a discussion was led by PAPA Lobbyist, Ms. Sue Griffith. Special thanks to Mr. Ed Torrez for facilitating the meeting. It is very important that our community show support for charter schools as there is proposed legislation that will eliminate a large portion of our funding.

- Attendance Rate = 94%

Student Academics/AYP:

- Congratulations to PAPA students! PAPA recently received an award from the New Mexico ACT Council (see attached). We were one of seven schools in the state to be awarded for increasing the number of students taking the ACT while increasing the average composite score over a five year period.
- Congratulations to the following PAPA students: Ruth Fogelman, Alexys Garcia, Racquel Garcia and Ashley Garcia. They won first place in the statewide SMG-Stock Market Game in which 400+ teams participated. PAPA also had the fourth, fifth, and sixth place teams. The teams were sponsored by Mr. Ted Wallack.
- ELL screening took place. Nine students qualified and were given the W-APT test. All students tested proficient in English.
- The first round of short-cycle assessments were completed for students in grades 9 and 10. We are awaiting the results.

Performing Arts:

- Congratulations to Ms. Carolina Gonzales, Mr. Ed Torrez, Mr. Josh Morales, Mr. George Bailey, Ms. Maile Soon and their students! The orchestra, choir and guitar classes put on fabulous concerts! Musical Theater put on three exciting performances of "Give My Regards to Broadway". The middle and high school art shows displayed some very talented works of art!
- Ms. Naomi Montoya arranged for a group of PAPA contemporary dance ensemble students to audition to perform with the Graham Company at Popejoy Hall in the spring. Kalin Wood was chosen as an understudy.
