New Students:

- Lottery Applications by Grade Level: 6-110; 7-22; 8-30; 9-34; 10-2; 11-8; 12-1
- Suggestion for Enrollment Increase 2011-12: Increase the number of students in 6-9 to 60 each.
- The Open House was very successful. There was entertainment, snacks from the PTSO, many applications received/handed out, tours by current students, and excellent presentations in the classrooms. There was a large crowd the entire evening.

New Facility:

Daphne Benavides, Rhonda Cordova, and I met with Kizito Wijenje to discuss facility plans. In summary:

- The church building is in Phase II of the environmental assessment. Phase I showed plumes in the soil. The facility will need major improvements on electrical work and such. APS is paying for the environmental study.
- APS is looking for alternative locations. When we do get a facility, it will be turn-key ready.
- Mr. Winjenje thought we could be in this facility for a few more years. He encouraged us to write “needs” proposal indicating what changes/additions are necessary if we stay in this facility for a few more years.
- The \$2.8 million discussed at the PSCOC Task Force meeting is for a permanent facility, not to improve the current location.
- After much discussion about what money there is “banked” for PAPA (including HB33 and SB9), Mr. Winjenje stated he would provide us a link to the APS Master Plan website that will provide us with information about PAPA money.
- We plan to meet once per month. We have a meeting scheduled with Mark Tolley, Rose McKernan, and Kizito Wijenje on Wednesday, March 9th.

- We'll discuss the MOU and the creation of a required Performance Evaluation. We will also present our "needs" assessment of the current facility.

Staff:

- We had professional development at today's in-service. The math and English teachers assessed testing data from the 2 short-cycle assessments that our 9th and 10th graders took. The science and social studies teachers reviewed SBA released items. The arts teachers had a discussion on rigor and relevance in the arts. We also had a much needed staff meeting to plan and review (see attached agenda).
