The “Rising Stars” quilt is hand pieced, machine quilted and made of 100% cotton materials. It took between 150-200 hours to complete using approximately 17 yards of fabric and 10 yards of cotton batting to fill the middle. The completed size is 84”X96”, or 7’X8’, basically queen size. All materials and supplies were purchased locally, providing support to our community.

The name “Rising Stars” was given in honor of the past, present, and future stars who will come from PAPA. Many aspects of PAPA performing arts have been incorporated into the quilt. School colors were used. The quilting design is comedy/tragedy faces with ballet slippers in some areas. Music is represented with notes and instruments. The back is a southwest theme. The quilt even has the school mascot, the panda on the label.

Academically, the quilt creation included research, math, computer design and graphics. Quilting is a science as well as an art!
