

1st QUARTER ONLINE VIRTUAL LEARNING SYLLABUS AMENDMENT

Since we are starting the 2020-2021 school year virtually, due to Covid-19, there will be a few changes in the first quarter.

Make-up Work: Make-up work is essentially nonexistent. Since students will be at home, even if they are sick, they should still have the capacity to do the majority of the work. However, I know that there are situations that may necessitate the need to allow extensions on assignments. Yet, when referring to the *Missing, Late and Corrected work* section in the syllabus, students have ample time to make up assignments as the only disciplinary action taken for missing assignments is a loss of points within Classcraft.

Tardy to class

- The Golden Rule for tardiness is, "Early is on time! On time is late!"
- Students will be responsible for attending any scheduled Zoom meetings. If a student is late or missing from the meeting, they will lose points within Classcraft.

Missing, Late, and Corrected work

- Any assignment that is not submitted by the time listed on the Google Classroom Assignment will result in an automatic loss of health points in Classcraft.
- Any assignments that has not been turned in by the student may be submitted late.
- If a student wishes to improve their grade on an assignment by making corrections, they must gain prior approval by the instructor.
- Students have until the end of the week, prior to the end of the grading period to submit any missing, late, or corrected assignments.
