

# **Contact Tracing App**

NM Notify is a new service developed in partnership with Google and Apple to help slow the spread of COVID-19. By opting in, your Android or Apple device will share <u>anonymous</u> tokens with other NM Notify users using your phone's Bluetooth. If another user you've been near tests positive for COVID-19 within a 14-day period, you will be notified. If you test positive, your close contacts can be notified anonymously that they have been exposed to COVID-19 to stop the spread.

NM Notify, like wearing masks and keeping a safe distance, is another way to keep ourselves and our communities safe from the spread of COVID-19. ## What are the safety protocols?

Daily COVID screening before coming to school or at outside door of classroom (see papa website)

Water fountains closed (Bring own water bottle)

Maintain social distance & wear masks

Outside classrooms - be prepared!

#### Use hand sanitizer

Wash desks and chairs each period

**Directional halls** 

HEPA filters, 10% outside air flow

Daily deep cleaning

# What if my child feels sick at school?

Don't come to school if feeling ill

COVID screening at home to prevent unnecessary trip

If at school, tell teacher

Step outside of classroom

Office staff escort to isolation/waiting room

Parents called to pick up

Get a COVID test, notify school of results and remain at home 10 days from symptom onset, fever free for 72 hours, and resolving symptoms

## How does quarantine work at school?

After confirmed positive COVID case, any person who shared a classroom or who was in close contact will be notified.

Any close contacts will quarantine for 10 days unless vaccinated or past COVID.

Students in quarantine or sick continue school virtually

At the end of quarantine, return to school

# What about drop off and pick up?

As soon as dropped off, report to outside area designated by 1st period teacher for check in/COVID screening (best if completed and submitted at home)

Students arriving after the 1st period tardy bell report to main office Adult supervision to decrease congregating

Pick up and drop off at bus loop, west lot, dirt lot or nearby street (no pick up/drop off in fire lane)

#### What about restrooms?

Restrooms marked with capacity

If 2 people at sink, step out and wait in hall

Teacher flexibility with restroom trips during class

No changing in restrooms

#### What about lunch?

Two lunches (HS and MS)

Students enter east side of Cafe

If bringing own lunch, go directly outside

Students encouraged to eat outside

Wash hands

Social distance markers on tables

Adult supervision

LUNCH IS FREE FOR EVERYONE!

COVID screening has lunch count on it

### What about dance, choir and band classes?

Come dressed for dance

If must change, wear quick change items

No changing in restrooms

Use outside spaces and Cafe

Wear weather-appropriate clothing

Bring instruments daily Choir outdoor, masks, 9 ft Band outdoor, masks, 9 ft Wear weather-appropriate clothing

# What to bring?

Bring a back up face mask

Dress in layers, rooms are cool

Full water bottle

Fully Charged Laptop and charger

Backpack (no lockers)

Individual learning tools, pencils, pens, colored pencils etc.

A towel for outside seating
