Purpose:

This study skills class is designed to support student learning in their other classes. Students have been assigned this class by IEP or 504 plan based on their need for support. This class is a credit graded class and students need to do the required work/activities designed to support them in order to pass this class.

Daily Check In: Students that are passing all their classes will just check in quickly to tell me what they are working on. If students are failing or in danger of failing, they will be required to fill out a Google Form with their plan for the day, including what they are doing to recover in the low class(es). If someone is absent there is an assignment to make up the missed points.

Grade Check/Goal Setting: Students will have a weekly assignment that will be either a goal setting for the quarter (at the beginning of each quarter) or a grade check due each week. It will be due on the last day of the week. I will accept it as late as Sunday at 8:00pm for full credit. After that they need to speak with me about a make-up.

Attendance/ Participation: Students will be graded based on their working appropriately and following classroom expectations/guidelines.

Work quietly (minimal conversation) the whole class period.

No videos that are not a direct assignment.

No leaving the classroom to work unless you have a note from that teacher.

No working outside or in the hallways, you must stay in the classroom.
