Grading:

Grades will be entered into Power School on a weekly basis for student/parent/ guardian review. Artwork will be assessed per the Art Rubric, see below. Assignments be self-assessed as well as teacher-assessed.

High School=

50% Projects + 30% Daily work + 20% weekly participation = Total Grade

Middle School=

50% Projects + 30% Daily work + 20% weekly participation = Total Grade

How do I get an "A" in Art?

(Art Rubric)

100-90 points= Exemplary – Followed ALL directions;EXTREME effort; Contrast shown; COMPLETE; Neat; Balanced.

89-80 points = Proficient- "Exemplary" with minor infractions.

79-70 points = Progressing - Some of the items in "Exemplary" are not evident.

69-60 points = Needs Improvement – More than "some" of the items in "Exemplary" are not evident.

59-below= Not Meeting Standards; Incomplete;Minimal effort; Major infractions from exemplary.

Turn in your work- completed and on time.

Put in the effort. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS.

Cell Phone and Earbud Policies

You MUST keep your cell phone and wireless earbuds in YOUR BACKPACK. If you don't, I will ask you to put them away. If you do not, I will call the office for someone to come and pick up your items up and they will keep them in the office and notify your parent/guardian to keep them until the end of the day. If you need something, we have tablets and iPads. Earbuds that you plug into your laptop are allowed with permission from Ms. Chandler, one ear only.

Absences: Students must talk with me about missing work, and we plan a due date together. If they are excused absent, they still must make up their missing work. If a student is 15 minutes or more late, they will be marked absent unexcused. If a student does not come to class and is somewhere else WITHOUT MY PERMISSION, they will be marked absent unexcused.

Tardies: Students must have a pass or they will be marked tardy unexcused.

Late Work: I will grade projects late, but not Daily work/DO NOWs, unless the student has been absent excused.

Homework: I do not assign homework. Students work at home if they want to, but this is not expected. I WANT students to do their work IN CLASS. Sometimes students have special supplies they want to use. If we don't have it in class, they can come talk to me, and we can try to purchase the supplies they need.

Regrade: Students have the option to re-do a project for a better grade or add to the project for a higher grade.

Hall Passes- One student out of class at a time, with a paper pass, unless it is a quick errand and then we use plastic passes on lanyards. Students MUST HAVE MY PERMISSION to be out of the classroom. If a student is out more than 5 minutes, the office will be notified.
